



Customer Information – Declaration REACH

What is REACH?

Registration, evaluation, authorization (release) and restriction of chemicals
- stands for a chemicals law within the EU.

The core aspects are:

- Clear regulation of the registration and authorization of "chemicals":

All "substances" (chemicals) from one tonne per year of production / import must be registered by the manufacturers / importers. Registration takes place exclusively with the European Chemical Agency (ECHA).

- Reversal of the burden of proof on the manufacturer of "chemicals":

The manufacturer has to inform his customers "actively" about the use of "substances of concern" ("SVHC" list) within the meaning of REACH or to offer alternatives.

This means that Mawick has to be informed "actively" by its suppliers and then has to inform its customers "actively".

- No Data - No Market (no registration - no marketing)

What does this mean for Mawick ?

Mawick neither manufactures chemical substances nor imports them from outside the EU.
With regard to the manufacture,

Mawick is a downstream user (e.g. cleaning, painting and assembly of components). This means that we use different chemicals for the manufacture of our products.

This also applies for components & products which Mawick places on the market as dealer and imports from the outside of the EU.

Our principle products are manufactured items and not chemical substances within the meaning of REACH, and they do not release such chemical substances during their application. Therefore, the registration obligation does not apply to our products. Liquids such as cooling liquids and machine oils are used as provided by our suppliers and any registration duties are fulfilled through the suppliers.

What are our activities?

Mawick maintains contact with its suppliers to verify whether they are aware of our application of their product and that concerned chemical substances have been registered or and/or preparations will be registered.

Mawick observes all currently known SVHC "substances of concern" on the constantly updated SVHC list and the related consolidating versions.


In addition to that, all current international regulations and laws are constantly reviewed and observed.

Furthermore, our general terms and conditions of purchase contain a clear requirement to our contractual partners to supply us exclusively with articles which comply with the relevant legal regulations and the official regulations.

Based on the aforementioned information / activities and according to the current state of our knowledge we confirm that our products comply with the requirements of the REACH directive 1907/2006/EG as well as the actual entire current SVHC query list and other applicable documents.

In the improbable event of a change to our delivery capability caused by REACH, we would promptly inform you and agree suitable measures with you.
